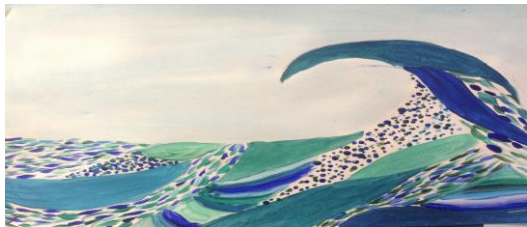
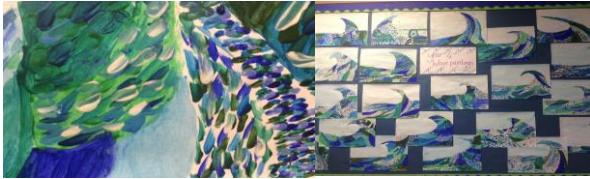


LEARNING AT CHARFIELD
