Today has been the most exciting day of the week as we have watched the Panache steel band perform and completed workshops with them, experiencing the thrill of playing the drums for ourselves. MUSIC INFORMATION



Ms Alison Whitfield will be joining us to continue woodwind lessons for pupils at a cost of £7.00 per lesson. Lessons will continue on an individual basis for a 15 minute time slot. Alternatively children can be part of a paired or small group session for 30 minutes. Ms Whitfield has experience teaching a range of instruments including flute, clarinet, recorder and saxophone. Recorder lessons will remain at £25 for 10 group lessons. Lessons will take place on a Tuesday morning.

Mr David Beale will be joining us to teach those pupils who take guitar lessons at a cost of £7.00 per lesson for 10 sessions. Lessons will continue in paired sessions for 30 minutes. Mr Beale has experience teaching classical piano, Spanish classical guitar, steel string guitar, bass guitar and the electric guitar. Lessons will take place on a Thursday morning.
