NEW REWARD SYSTEM

After the Easter break we will begin a new reward system in school. The system is called 'You've Been Spotted'.

How does it work?

Every child will have a 'You've Been Spotted' sheet in school. When they are spotted doing something good they will be awarded a green sticker. The stickers go on their sheet.

When they earn 10 they would be awarded a 'You've Been Spotted' certificate.

The stickers earned will still go towards their team scores and class scores for the weekly assembly.

How can parents help?

There are a few ways you can help promote this system.

1. Ask your child how many stickers they have earned.



2. LEAP awards - Encourage them to bring in evidence for LEAP. Children are given stickers for bringing in evidence
3. 'Achievements Outside School' - Stickers are awarded to children who bring in their awards gained outside school.
4. Negotiate a manageable reward if your child brings home a 'You've Been Spotted' certificate. For example cooking with you or a trip to the park.
