

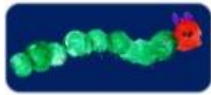

4 & 9 are a bit different. They are written like:
4 = IV (1 before 5)
9 = IX (1 before 10)

You cannot have more than three of the same numeral in a row.
