We would like to say a huge thank you to those parents that gave up their time to transport the children to this wonderfully enriching experience.

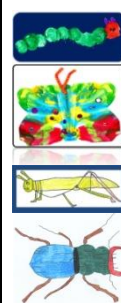
### SCIENCE FOCUS WEEK
