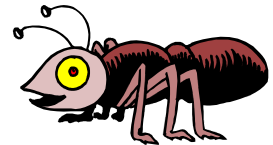

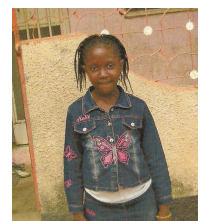
HAVE YOU GOT ANTS IN YOUR LUNCHBOX??
