# Agreement for Parents/Carers

- 1 make sure that my child attends school regularly and is on time for school. If my child is absent, contact the school on the first day of their absence
- 2 encourage my child to work hard and do all the homework tasks

- 4 ensure that the school has an up to date emergency contact phone number
- 5 see that my child wears the school colours and all their property is clearly labelled
- 6 work with the school to try and make sure that my child behaves well and get in touch if there are any problems at home that may affect my child's work or behaviour
- 7 attend open evenings for parents
- 8 reply to any school correspondence
