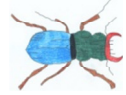
### MID YEAR REPORTS

My 'Class of The Week' trophy goes to Grasshopper Class. This week I watched the class program 'Pro-Bots' to make right angled turns. I was impressed with their

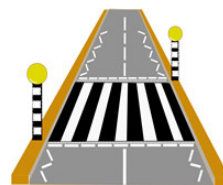
collaboration & enthusiasm to get the programs to work correctly.







A reminder that the meeting to discuss installing new crossing lights near the Railway Tavern and the Garage.
