Art and Chess club have moved to Wednesdays starting on 12<sup>th</sup> March. This will be the new day until at least the end of T4.

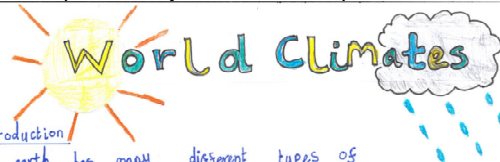


## LEARNING AT CHARFIELD

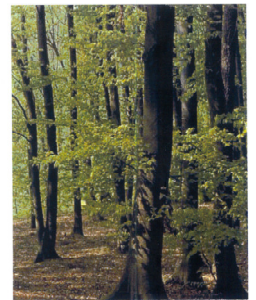


#### Introduction
